

We conducted two parallel technical sessions - Finance Track and Management Track. We received 17 articles from academicians and researchers. Paper presenters were from different districts of West Bengal.






Valedictory Session


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
POSTER PRESENTATION ORGANIZED BY DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY




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CAREER COUNSELING PROGRAMME
