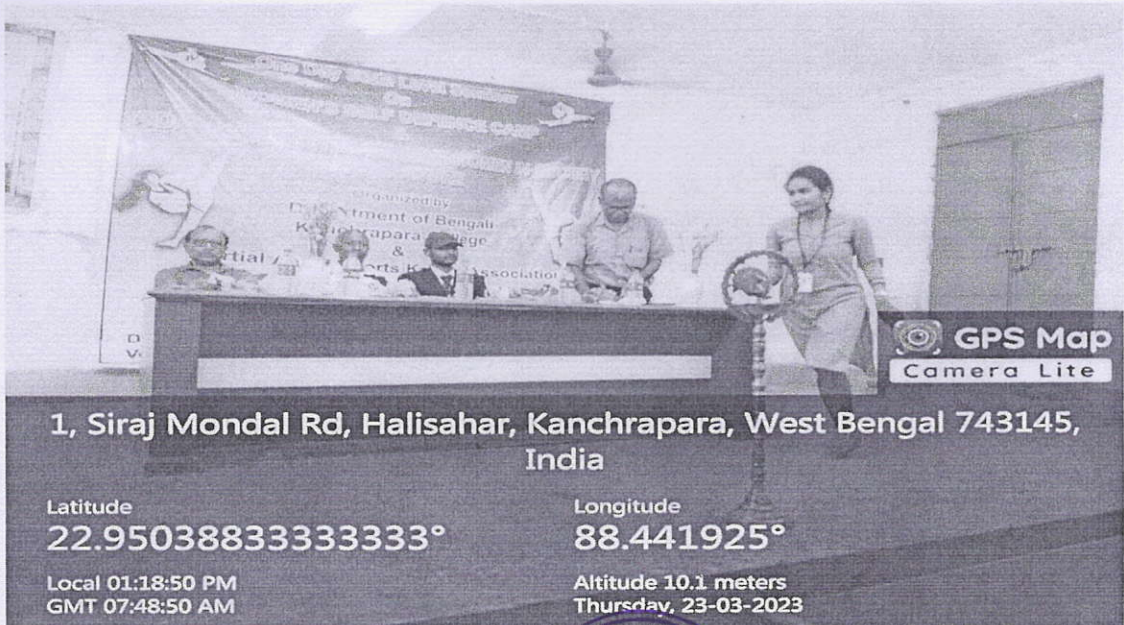

Toilet relief for transgender students

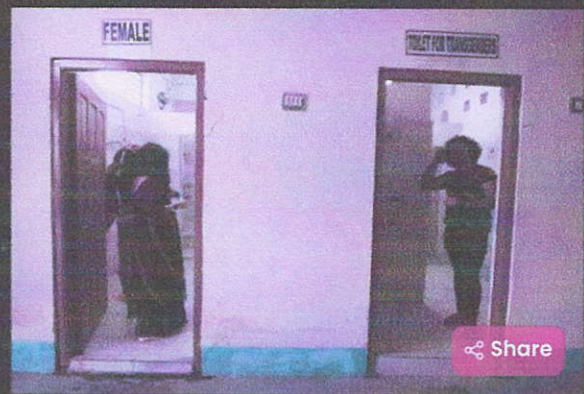
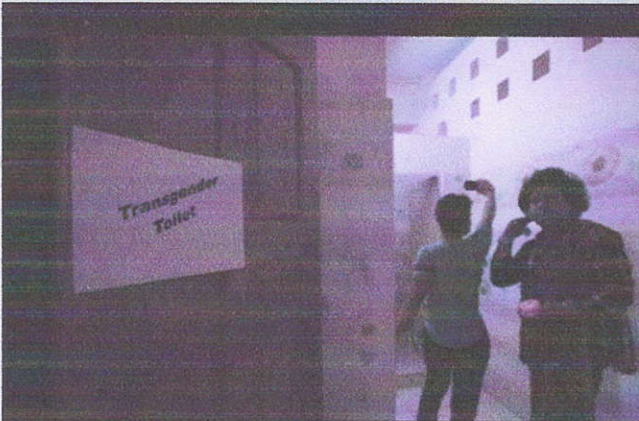

Being a member of the transgender community, Argha Roy Chowdhury (aka Silk), never felt safe using the men's toilet. And after a certain age and a number of horrific incidents, Argha stopped using it when he was in Class VII. During emergencies, he would run 20 minutes to reach home rather than visiting the boys'

room in school. This continued even after he joined Kanchrapara College in 2011. "A toilet is a basic amenity and no one should have to struggle for that," he said. To ensure that none of the 15 other transgender students of Kanchrapara College face this situation in their lives, Argha took the initiative to construct a transgender toilet in the college with the help of college authorities. This makes the college the first institution in West Bengal and the second in the country, after Punjab

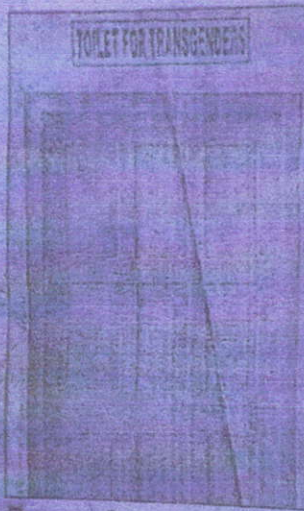

Key Note Speakers:



Dr. Mary Shenk is an Associate Professor of Anthropology, Demography & Asian Studies and Director of Graduate Studies, Department of Anthropology, Pennsylvania State University. She completed her Ph.D. in Anthropology from the University of Washington. She is a renowned Anthropologist and demographer with interests in marriage, family, kinship, fertility, mortality, and inequality. She has conducted field research on the economics of marriage and parental investment in urban South India, the causes of rapid fertility decline in rural Bangladesh, and the effects of economic development on wealth, social networks, and health in Bangladesh and China. Her current work focuses on illuminating the mechanisms that underlie the relationships between religiosity, fertility, and child outcomes, and understanding shifting patterns of marriage, fertility, and family systems with economic development and social change. She has published over 50 articles, and her work has been funded by the U.S. National Science Foundation, the U.S. National Institutes of Health, and the John S. Templeton Foundation. At present through her Fulbright-Nehru project, Dr. Shenk is conducting research in Birbhum District, West Bengal, India in collaboration with Saswata Ghosh at the Institute for Development Studies Kolkata (IDSK) and researchers at the Society for Demographic Health and Surveillance (SDHS).

Dr. Saswata Ghosh is an Associate Professor at the Institute of Development Studies Kolkata (IDSK). He completed his Ph.D. in Population Studies from the Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU). He obtained Sir Ratan Tata Post-Doctoral Fellowship from the Asia Research Centre of London School of Economics (LSE) during 2014-15. He also received International Fellowship for Young Bio-Medical Scientists from the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) during 2012-13. He served as a Visiting Fellow at the LSE and at Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies (BIDS). He worked with Qatar Statistics Authority (QSA), Doha; Centre for Health Policy (CHP), ADRI, Patna; Population Council and Council for Social Development, New Delhi in various capacities. He has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals of international standing. He has co-edited (with Prof. Aparajita Chattopadhyay) the book titled "Population Dynamics in Eastern India and Bangladesh: Demographic, Health and Development Issues" published by the Springer Nature; Singapore. He is currently serving as a Member in International Advisory Board of Asian Population Studies Journal publish by Routledge. He was also member of Technical Resource Group (TRG) in developing framework for HIV/AIDS mortality estimation by the ICMR-NICED. His areas of interest include religious demography; fertility, family planning and son preference; family demography; field survey methods; demographic estimations; and econometric methods

To celebrate National Nutrition Month, 2022, the Department of Food & Nutrition, Kanchrapara College and IQAC cell of Kanchrapara College jointly organized an outreach program on menstrual hygiene among adolescent school girls.

This was an excellent initiative taken by the department and IQAC cell of the college as menstrual health is a fundamental concern among adolescent girls to maintain a healthy reproductive life.



National Nutrition Month 2022 was themed “Poshan Maah” by the National Institute of Nutrition, India. To celebrate this occasion, the department decided to organize an outreach program to educate school students about menstrual hygiene and nutrition during adolescence and reproductive age.

Mission:

- Celebration of National Nutrition Month, 2022
- Celebration of 50 years of Kanchrapara College
- Organize an outreach programme

Vision:

- Awareness generation about menstrual health and hygiene among adolescent school girls
- Preparing semester’s students to communicate with common people

For this purpose, the students of the Department of Food & Nutrition, Kanchrapara College with two faculty members and lab attendants were sent to a locally situated girls' school.

Programme Details

At 11 am on 13. 09. 2022, five students, with two faculty members and one laboratory attendant, arrived at the girls' school. More than 70 students and 15 teachers were gathered in the hall as the audience. First, all the college students and the faculty members communicated with the school students in a friendly way. This was to create an ambiance where students could freely talk about their menstrual problems to us as teenage girls are still shy about discussing menstruation openly. So first we made them understand that menstruation is a normal biological process and there is nothing to hide.

After a general interaction and counselling session, students from our department presented a model of the female reproductive system. They also delivered lectures about reproductive organs and menstrual bleeding.



Then, nutrition education was given to the school children. Students of our department made the school students understand basic nutritional needs during menstruation and the whole period of adolescence.

Afterward, students were taught basic menstrual hygiene. They are advised to use sanitary napkins, tampons, etc. The importance of maintaining hygiene and cleanliness of innerwear was also discussed.

Our students were talking about all the taboos we have created in our society regarding menstruation, which have no scientific basis.

A meeting with the school student was held to answer their questions at the end of this session.



A pack of two sanitary napkins was given to each audience member at the last session.

All in all, the whole event was wrapped in the joy and satisfaction of raising awareness, at least to a small but important segment of our people, about such an important and critical issue.
