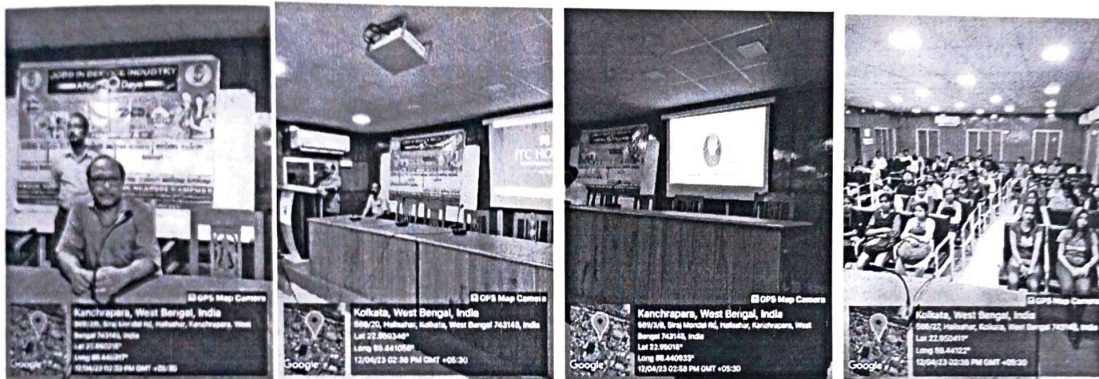


Skill Development Programme on Hospitality Management

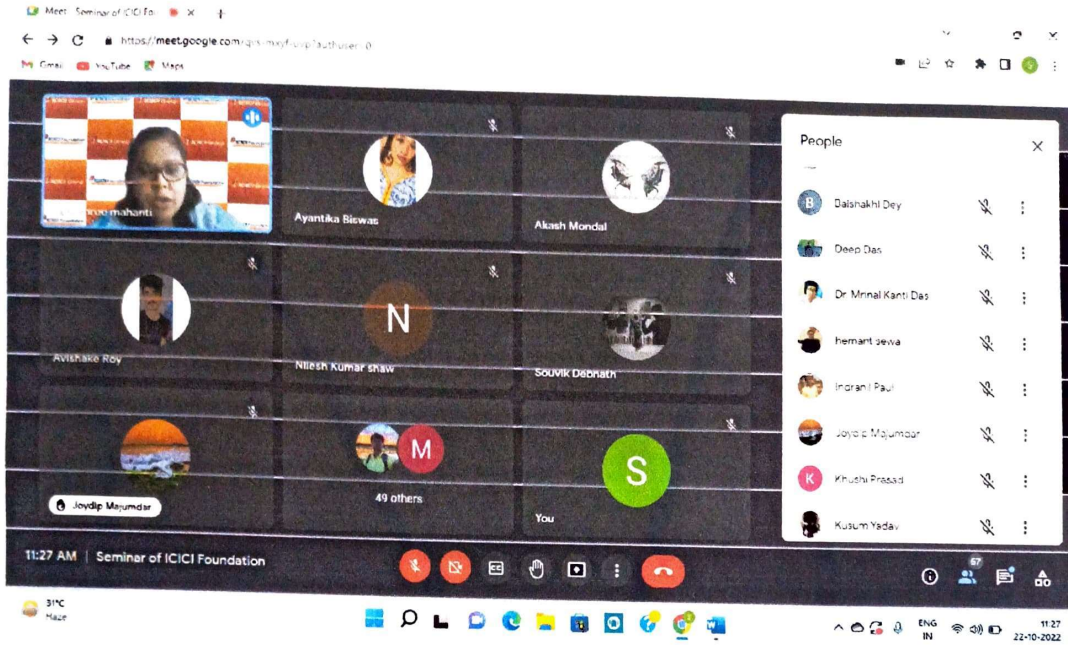
Key Highlights:



of urban water crises and governance mechanisms in India with a case study of Shimla. Soma has a Master's degree in Geography with the University Gold Medal for Academic Excellence from Sikkim University, and an M. Phil. in Development Studies from TISS, Mumbai, where she explored the spatialities of water in a caste society like India. Soma has presented her research at many international conferences and has also been engaged in a number of research projects on WASH, Forest Resource Rights and Governance Mapping and Green Economy. Her broad research interests include environmental governance and policy, political ecologies of water, climate change, gender & urban studies.

We began our programme by welcoming the speaker and the participants. At the outset the Jt. Convenor also introduced the speaker and gave a brief about her academic career (See the photo below)

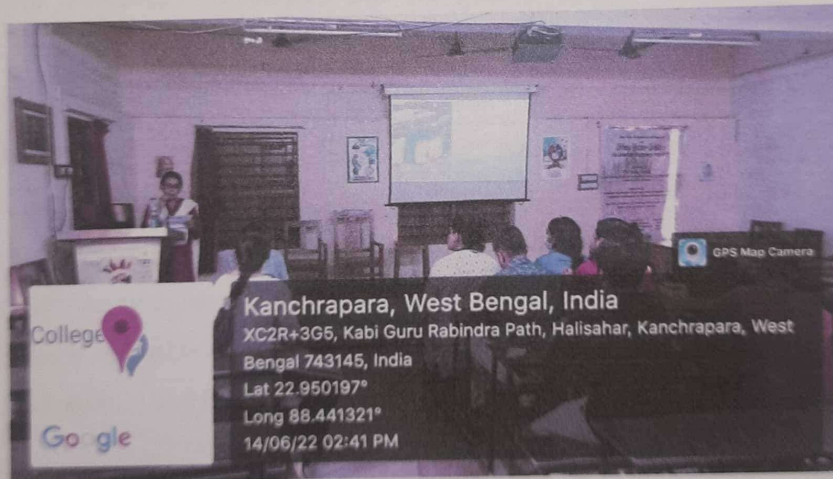

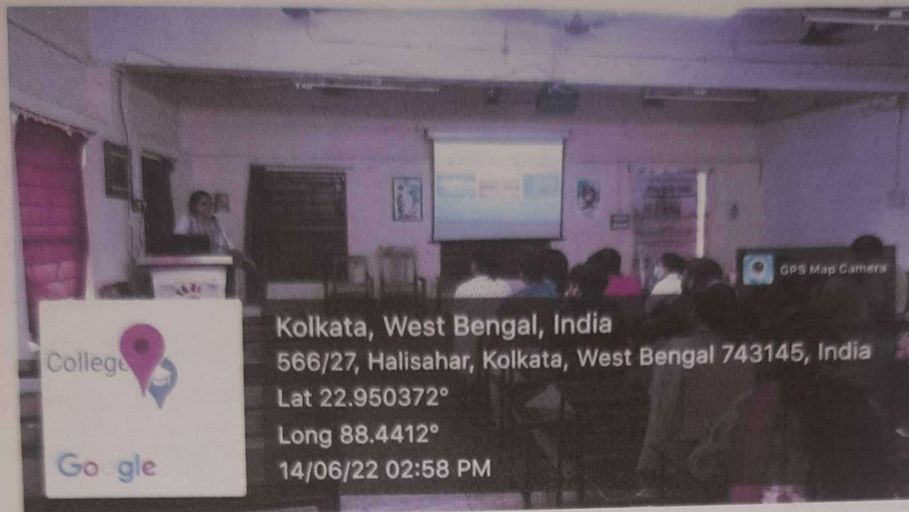

Presentation by the Speaker

Ms. Soma Sarkar spoke on the topic of urban water crisis from a multi-disciplinary perspective referring to both theoretical approaches and her own extensive and intensive fieldwork-based evidence (see the above photo). Water and urban environments co-evolve continuously through intricate interrelationships that are temporally contingent, and spatially variable, moving across non-linear progressions. This leads to unceasingly embryonic urban and resource configurations. Over the years, many cities across the world have experienced major water shortages with differential impacts on the different sections of society. This lecture was designed to create an understanding of the contested nature of waterscapes in a city. It drew upon Elinor Ostrom's Bundle of Rights to explain case studies from Purulia and Shimla and urged for a multi-method and multi-stakeholders' inquiry to understand water contestations.

In her presentation, Ms. Sarkar elucidated the multifaceted nature of the urban water crisis, addressing its socio-economic, environmental, and governance aspects. Drawing from her research findings, she underscored the unequal distribution of water resources within urban landscapes, exacerbating disparities and vulnerabilities among different socio-economic groups.

Ms. Sarkar also shed light on the role of governance structures, policy frameworks, and community participation in mitigating the urban water crisis. Her interdisciplinary approach provided valuable insights into the complexities of water management, emphasizing the need for holistic strategies and collaborative efforts.



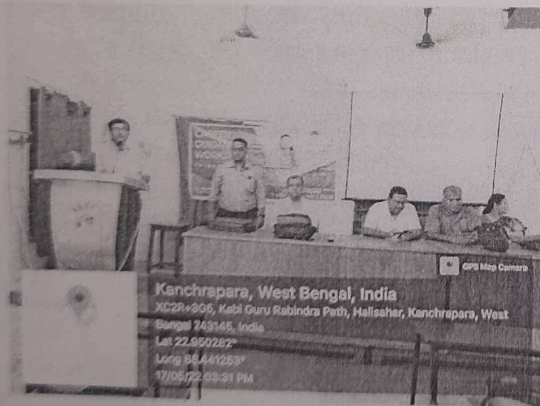


Two-day Career Guidance Workshop on ITR I & 2 and GST return

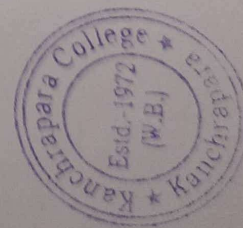

The programme started at 3:30 PM with the welcome address by Dr. Mrinal Kanti Das, Head, Department of Commerce. Opening remarks and introduction of the programme was given by Dr. Subhabrata De, NAAC joint-coordinator. The dignitaries on the dias were Dr. Pradip Kumar Biswas, IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Subhabrata De, NAAC joint-coordinator and Pradip Samanta, resource person for the session. The first day of workshop focused on GST Return. The students of 4th and 6th semester participated in the first day workshop with zeal and enthusiasm. The speaker has enlightened the students about GST return, who should file this return, how many returns are there under GST, different types of GST returns and due dates to file them etc. Through this workshop, the students learnt how to get a firm registered under GST Act, 2017, the basic structure of GST and how to file various GST returns. 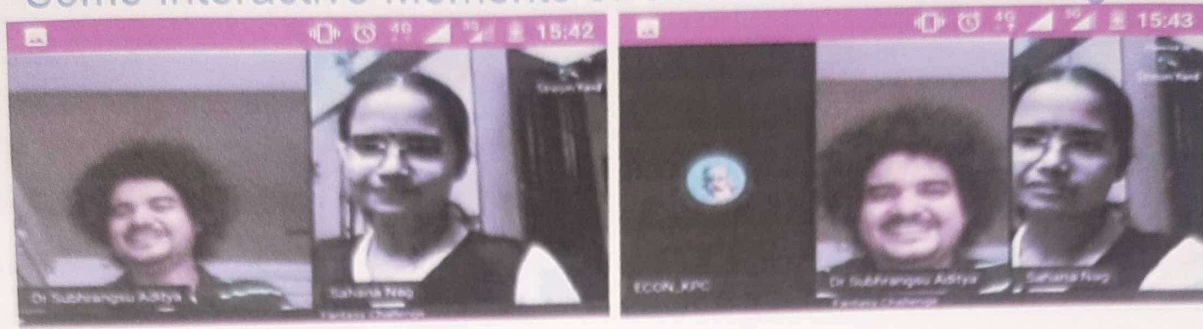
Session 2: "Coping Strategies and Support Systems"

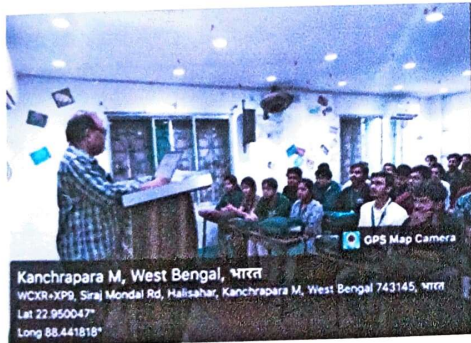
